

Nenthorn Equestrian Winter Livery 2015/16

- 1) As of October 1st 2015 the fields will be changed, see Jenny for which field your horse will be in.
- 2) Any breakages- to fencing/gates/equipment/lorry/lead ropes/buckets you must either replace or we will add it to your bill.
- 3) The shower will only be switched on when weather is good - £5 when you use it after 1st October- however you must ask permission first as it will be switched off when frozen.
- 4) School lessons will take priority; the schools must be booked in advanced - see Jenny. It has been noted that dung is not always lifted when you use the schools- this will change and I will add an extra £5 to your bill if you leave either your stable or school in a mess.
- 5) You are not allowed to use the fillers or water tray/wall when you are not participating in a lesson, however you may hire them.
- 6) Breakages must be reported to Jenny otherwise you will be billed for them.
- 7) We will on a daily basis:
 - check your horse
 - check water
 - check fencing
- 8) We will not be responsible for changing rugs/bringing in for farrier unless previously arranged.
- 9) The new indoor school (exciting!!!)
 - must be pre-booked
 - when up and running there will be a livery hour three nights a week and some over the weekend(tbc)
 - competitions(liveries will receive discounts for competitions held at NEC)
- 10) grooming services
 - mane pulling £10
 - clipping (including feathers) £50
 - Clipping yourselves- clipping hire- £20- however if you break them you pay for them- £25 is doing feathers (they clog up the blades and blunt them.
- 11) Transport
 - Kelso £10
 - Holefield £15
 - Beyond 20 miles £30 (per horse)
- 12) Horses will next be worm counted 1st November- if there is a worm count present we will worm them (£20), if no count they will continue to be worm counted (£10) until due again.

Livery Packages

1) There is no DIY in the winter.

2) Basic livery package. Grass livery this includes hay in the field.

- Horse £40 per week.
- Pony £30 per week.

Your horse/pony will be brought down four times a week and will include hay in the field only. You must leave a feed for them in bins provided when they come in. They can have nights in when weather is bad or competitions at an extra £5 per night.

3) Part livery

- Horse £35 per week if living out. £50 if in at night
- Pony £30 per week if living out. £50 if in at night

We can use your horse/pony up to 7 hours a week. When we use them, we feed them. They will receive free balancer and red mineral. Hay is provided in both stable and field. Your horse/pony will be brought in for the farrier/vet. Will be in on bad nights depending on age.

4) Full Livery

- Horse £80 per week.
- Pony £60 per week.

Your horse/pony will be in at night and out during the day. On days where you are riding your horse will not be turned out. One haynet and x2 feeds daily. Once there is no grass a small haynet in the morning is provided. They will get their own stable. Horse/pony will never be used in school. Please note any additional feeding your horse needs you must provide (see Jenny).

5) Exclusive livery

- £120 per week.

All of the above. We will exercise and keep your horse fit. This includes mane pulling/grooming but not clipping.
